Topic: Google Maps and Using Apps

### Today's Goals

- Talk about what apps are and navigate to the app store
- Download Google Maps from the App Store on your phone

- Navigate to Google Maps on a computer browser
- Practice using Google Maps to find helpful information like directions and phone numbers.

#### Apps and the App Store

- Discuss what an app is. You can utilize the video on next page to help with this.
  - Apps are extra programs you can download onto a device (mainly cell phones) that can serve many purposes.
- Explain that there are apps pre-downloaded on our phones, such as Email and Settings, but that one can also download other apps for specific purposes, such as Google Maps or Duolingo.
- Help participants navigate to the app store (log in if needed and write login information) and search for Google maps.
- Guide participants to download the Google Maps app from the App store on their phone.







### Google Maps




- After discussing what an app is and giving some examples, introduce Google Maps.
  - "Google Maps is an example of an app that you can use to locate different services or places around you, and using your phone you can route from your current location or a pre-determined area to direct you to a specific location."
- Use the video on the next page to explain the basic function of Google Maps, if needed.
- Begin by directing the client to download Google Maps and log in with their Gmail account.
- Next, pick a location nearby or the client's address- somewhere familiar to them.
- Show the client how to use the search bar, as well as the difference between the starting and end location.



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


# The Google Maps Mobile App Overview:




### Google Maps Bus Mode:



- If you don't have a car,
   Google Maps can help you navigate public transportation.
- It tells you how long it will take to walk to the bus stop.
- It tells you how long your total trip will take.
- It tells you how much the bus fare will cost.



### Google Maps Walking Mode:




- Even if you're just walking, Google Maps can still help you get where you need to go.
- The blue dotted line shows the best walking route. It guides you where there are sidewalks and crosswalks.
- Here, it tells you how long it will take to walk, what the distance is, and that the route is mostly flat, so it should be an easy walk.

# What Else Can Google Maps do?

Google Maps can do more than give you directions to a destination via bus, car, or walking. You can also use it to find information about businesses like what hours they're open, their phone number, website, and other information like how to schedule an appointment (at an urgent care clinic, for example).
